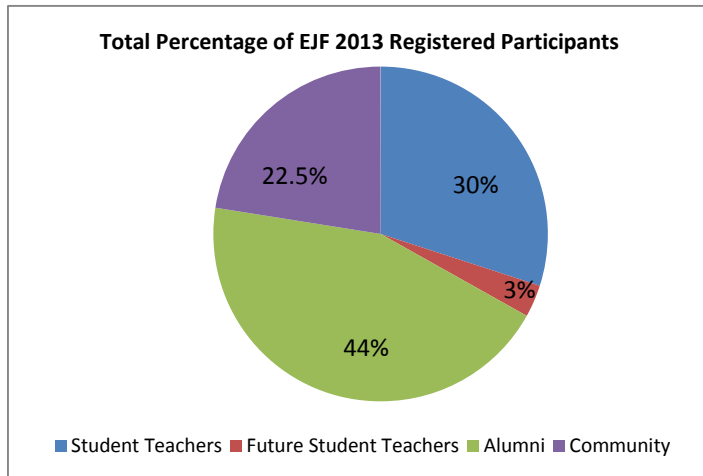
New Mexico State University Educators' Job Fair

The Educators' Job Fair is a two-day event, co-sponsored by Career Services and the College of Education, held every April. The Educators' Job Fair allows candidates and numerous school districts located throughout the nation to discuss career options and employment opportunities in a formal interview setting. The format of structured interviews is key to the fair's success. The majority of the candidates are from New Mexico State University, Western New Mexico University, and the region. However, a growing number of candidates from across the United States are utilizing this event to secure teaching positions.

The total number of NMSU College of Education or other College student teachers in Spring 2013 was 86. This figure is based on the number of undergraduate student teachers who applied for graduation per a report (Cognos SP 2013 Seniors CoED) generated from the NMSU COGNOS system on 5/29/2013. This report only indicates student teachers who applied for graduation; not those who actually graduated. The Educators' Job Fair participation report indicates that 34 NMSU student teachers participated in the two-day event.
