



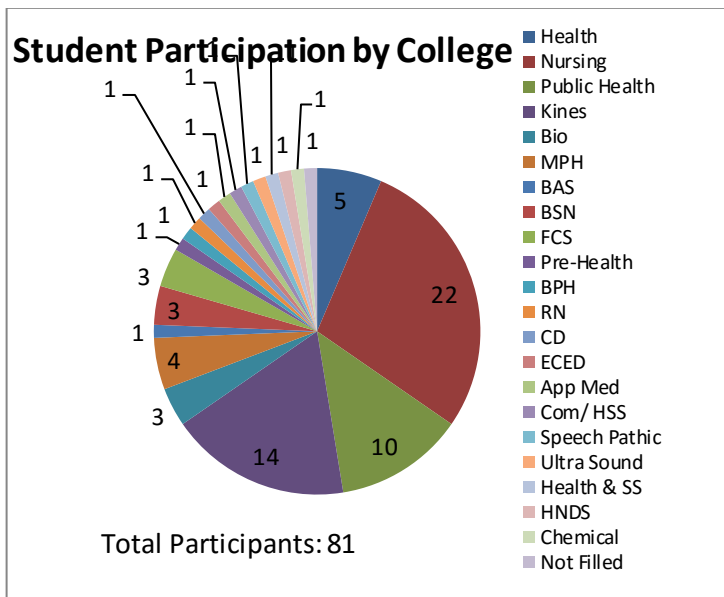

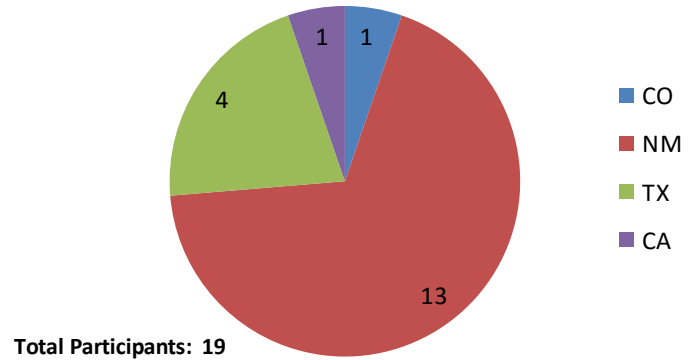
New Mexico State University Health Professions Career Fair

This was the inaugural year in which NMSU Career Services Department and the College of Health and Social Services co-sponsored the event to provide students, alumni, and community members an opportunity to meet with representatives from hospitals and social service agencies seeking to hire in nursing or other health related professions from (College of ACES: Human Nutrition & Dietetic Science, Family and Consumer Science; College of Education: Counseling and Ed Psychology, Kinesiology, Special Ed and Communication Disorders; and College of Health and Social Services: Nursing, Public Health Sciences, and Social Work).



The health industry is one of the largest industries in the country, with nearly 22 million jobs projected for 2022. Employment in the healthcare and social assistance industry is projected to increase 29 percent through 2022, compared to an average of 11 percent for all industries.
