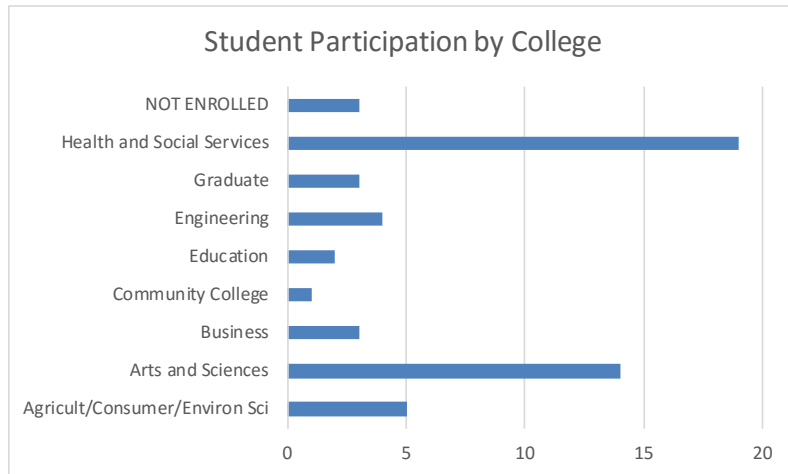


Career Services - 2017 Health Professions Career Fair

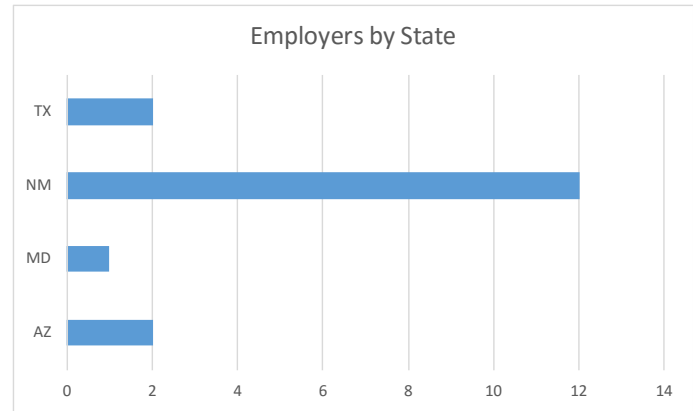


Fact Sheet
